We have just finished unloading the last of two containers that Mission of Love sent filled with love for the Mayan people in need of Guatemala. It was a long and bureaucratic process to have the two containers brought to Tecpan, but finally today the miracle occurred. A group of over 40 community volunteers (young and elder) joined hands to unload the “Love Containers”.



Not even the rain stopped us from working together to unload the precious cargo that was sent by Kathy Price and Mission of Love. These containers brought construction materials such as vinyl siding, wood, wheel chair ramp, and doors that will be used in the construction of the House of Dreams, medical and dental clinics and the re-construction of little homes (like Letty’s) that have been destroyed by the weather and poor maintenance.



Other precious goods like adult diapers, wheel chairs, medicines, clothes, bicycle, basketball hoops, playground, church pews, school and office supplies were also received, stored, sorted, organized and then delivered to the people in need.
