Dear Mrs. Price,

I am writing you on behalf of WAY-bi Foundation. WAY-bi is a nonprofit organization that is working to improve the living conditions of Tecpan communities and is currently working in different projects such as: the House of Dreams: a project that will shelter children with terminal disease diagnosis and their families; Bocalan: that implements animal assisted therapies; and the construction of dental and medical clinics.

Tecpan is a rural community of 81,100 inhabitants belonging to the department of Chimaltenango and is located 88 kilometers from Guatemala City. Its main economic activities are agriculture and tourism as in Tecpan is located the first Spaniard city named Iximché.

WAY-bi is focusing its efforts on improving the living conditions of the people in need of Tecpan and its communities. Health services are limited and difficult to access. Most of the times parents have to walk 5 to 15 miles in order to get to the nearest health center and sometimes attention, doctors, medical supplies or medical equipment are not always available. Many times people can't be treated because even regional hospitals lack of basic equipment and transportation.

This is why WAY-bi is currently working on the construction of medical and dental clinics for the communities of Tecpan that will have basic services and transportation options available. **WAY-bi therefore asks for your help in donating a full equipped Ambulance for the medical clinic.**

Your help with this equipment would go a long way and benefit many people in need. Many children, young adults, adults and elders will be able to use this service immediately.
